

Shikshapatri

The Epistle of Precepts
(based on Shatanand's Shikshapatri
Arthadipika)

Text 32

One shall never excrete, urinate or spit in places which have been prohibited by religious scriptures and society (dilapidated temples, banks of rivers or ponds, main roads, fields sown with seeds, shades of trees, orchards, gardens).

Staneshu Lokashastrabhyam

Nishidveshu Kadachana /

Malamutrotsarjanam Cha Na Karyam

Stivanam Tatha //

Those places (*Sthaneshu*) forbidden (*Nishidveshu*) by society (*Loka*) and scriptures (*Shastras*) should never (*Kadachana*) be excreted (*Mal*), urinated (*Mutram*) in nor spitted (*Stivanam*) upon.

Shatanand forbids the pass of nose mucus in such places as well. He further adds to the list of places which should not be violated in this way; firstly the places prohibited by society are as follows – near somebody else's house, in a king's place of residence and near the place of an armed warrior. Secondly the places prohibited by Shastras are: where cows are kept, near a burrow, in water (pond etc.), in a pile of ashes, an estuary where animals live, standing in a path, in front of or in close proximity of either a cow, Brahmin, sun, moon, fire, Guru, women and God, a ploughed field, banks of a river, in sand, an old ruin, in a temple of God, in a road, a cleansed area and without covering your

head.

Thus these places as ordained by **Skanda Purana** and so shall never be excreted or urinated in. hence all places other than those mentioned may be used for excretion purposes. The twelve forms of excretion (*Mal*) are given in **Sharirik Samgraha**: (i) tallow (ii) semen (iii) blood (iv) the marrow of a bone (v) urine (vi) excrement (dung) (vii) ear and skin dirt (wax) (viii) nails (ix) nose mucus (x) tears (xi) eye mucus and (xi) perspiration. The Lord has mentioned only two forms of excretion (*Mal*) in the original text but all such forms of *Mal* should not be passed in such places.

This Shloka seems blatantly obvious but it had to be included in the Shikshapatri as often we may pass such excretion without thought. In essences we really should perform calls of nature in one's home – bathroom/ toilet as such places is designated for such action. Never should we perform such act outside in the open air.

Lord Swaminarayan calls for hygiene and social decorum here. Passing bodily filth in various places mentioned is uncivilized, impure and an insult. Purity and cleanliness are human directives. Nature and the world around us are to be kept pure and clean and never to be made filthy by passing of bodily waste. Nature is home to many creatures and so we should respect it by keeping it clean just as we keep our own homes clean. We have absolutely no right to pass filth in such places. One must always, even in times of desperation, be civilized and never violate the world around us.

Many diseases are caused by such dirt being exposes to the land and air. An improper sewage system causes great illness to those in close proximity and therefore it is vital that we have respect for nature and the world we live in.

Alms

All of us have heard much about alms and even in the scriptures importance of alms is described much. Alms is considered to be an ornament of Dharma (religion). Just as human body is cleansed through bath and human mind is purified through worship of the Lord Shree Hari, similarly the wealth and money earned are sanctified and purified through alms. And therefore only we offer 1/10 or 1/20 part of our earnings to the Almighty God.

Even the Lord Shree Swaminarayan has given us directions in Shloka-147 of 'Shiksha Patri' as under:

"They shall donate one tenth of their earnings, money or food grains, to

Lord Shree Krishna. Those with insufficient income shall offer one twentieth."

In 'Shrimad Satsangi Jeevan', Satanand Swami has narrated the rituals to be performed for such alms. For example there is much importance of giving alms on the days like Kartik Sud-9, Maha Sud-7, Vaisakh Sud-2, on one's own birthday, on the festive days of Annakut etc. and on the pious days of 'Makar Sankranti' and also on the days of solar and lunar eclipse.

In 'Niti-Shatak' three movements of money are described. One is towards Alms, the other is Consumption and the third is Destruction. A person earns noble fruits by giving alms of his earnings, by consuming the earnings one assures subsistence and nourishment and without these two, the money or wealth gets destroyed. There is a very popular saying in our culture: "**One earns fruits as per his deeds.**" Those persons who use their money for the noble purpose, get happiness and peace in life and those who do not use their money for the noble purpose, get miseries and unhappiness in life. We get our money from our bank account, if we have deposited it earlier; similarly we would earn the fruits of our deeds performed in this life.

There are two types of alms. One type is in which we earn and enjoy the fruits of giving alms. And the second type is the one in which we perform the noble act of giving alms as per the directions of the Almighty Lord. If the alms are given keeping in

the mind that, the acts are being performed as per the directions of the Lord then it is considered a kind of worship and one earns the pleasure of the Almighty Lord and at last a place in Paramdham. Therefore Nishkulandan Swami states:

"જાવું છે, રે જાવું છે, રે આપો જમણે હાથ રે,
આવે સાથે રે, જીવ જાવું છે.
જાવું છે રે જાવું છે, રે માલ ધન મેલી,
કાંણ ઠેલી રે. જીવ જાવું છે."

The scriptures state that, a man does not take anything with himself after his death nor he takes birth taking anything with himself. What he takes and carries with him is the fruits of his noble actions and deeds. There is one interesting story.

There were two rich brothers. One of them was a noble and ardently devout person. He used to perform noble deeds; whereas the other was superstitious and greedy by nature. Therefore he did not perform any noble deeds.

Once the elder brother fell sick; the younger brother came to see him. He brought the money which he had borrowed from his elder brother. At that time, the elder brother told him that since now he was not going to live in this world anymore, he may bring the borrowed money to the other world. The younger brother told him that, no one can bring anything to other world after this life; immediately the elder brother told him that, he (the younger brother) was simply accumulating wealth and was not performing noble deeds like giving alms as if everything was to come with him after his death. The younger brother understood the message; he begged pardon of his elder brother and from that day onwards he started using his wealth in the noble deeds of giving alms like his brother.

Whatever is there in this world is of the Almighty Lord and the Lord has granted all these things to us. And we have to give from such received things only.

A generous person was offering alms while keeping his head down; a saint asked the reason for the same. The person answered the saint as under:

"દન હાર કોઈ ઓર હે, દેત રહત દિન રેન
લોક ભરમહામપર ધરે, તાતે નીચે નેન."

Oh saint: The Almighty Lord has given me the money, I am only a medium and I keep on giving alms. But the people praise me which is a matter of shame for me and therefore I offer alms with my head down.

તન પવિત્ર સેવા કિયે, ધન પવિત્ર દીયે દાન,
મન પવિત્ર હરિ ભજન સે, ઈસ બિધ હો કલ્યાણ.

Tulsidasji was a great poet, saint and also a great devotee. He had surrendered his life to the Almighty Lord. He was so much devoted to the Lord that everything else appeared to him like poison. Among one of his many couplets, he has sung as under:

“જુકે પ્રિય ન રામ બેદેહી, સો ધારીએ,
કોટી બેદી રામ, જદ્ય થી પરમસેહી.”

“A person who does not cherish devotion and Bhakti towards Lord Rama and his great Bhakta, such a person should be left permanently even if he is our relative.”

Perhaps such a person may be very popular enjoying high status and importance in the society, he may be very rich and wealthy, he may be very learned and he may be a man of character; even then if he does not cherish faith and devotion towards the Almighty Lord, then he is Blind and Lame Person. And those who cherish company of such a person who is very rigid in his attitude towards the Lord, would lose their own worth.

As a result of the noble deeds of thousands of years, there happens rare Union with great saint or devotee. Therefore, one should see to it that, one does not waste his valuable time behind his family and other social preferences and preoccupations. Here the great devotee and poet- Tulsidasji- warns the devotees against such situations. A devotee should be very cautious and careful. Love and devotion towards the Almighty Lord is really worth and true treasure of life and all else is worthless.

“ન જો પિતા પ્રહલાદ, વિભીષણ બંધુ, ભરત મહતારી,
બલી ગુરુ ત્યાજે કેત રજ બની નારી, ભયે મૃદ મંગલકારી.”

Understanding of the devotees is reliant upon *Niyam*, *Nishchay* and *Paksha*. And this firm faith of a devotee which is like a mountain cannot be shaken by anybody. Moreover, very existence of the devotee on this earth is meant for his Lord only and he has to sacrifice this life also, as and when required by such situation. Many great devotees of our great past have set examples of ardent devotion to the Almighty Lord. The great Bhakta Prahlad did not get frightened from his demonic father. He accepted all types of physical as well as mental tortures, but he did not surrender his faith and was not ready to leave his devotion even for the sake of his life. Similarly, when the great king and demon Ravan kidnapped Sitamata and brought her in Lanka, his younger brother Vibhisan left his brother and sought the shelter at the feet of the Lord Rama. When mother Kaikeyi created

- Sadhu Ghanshyamprakashdas (Jamiyatpura, Mahant Swami)

havoc in the life of the Royal *Raghuvansha*, the great prince Bharat left his mother and preserved the shelter of *Dharma*.

Similarly the great king Bali left his Guru Sukracharya (Guru of the demons) and preferred to stay in *Patal* just for the words of his promise to the Almighty Lord. Many Gopis of Vraja left their husbands and ran towards Lord Krishna and sought peace and shelter in divine devotion of the Lord and as a result thereof, they got place in *Ruchas* (*Vedic Shloka*) of *Vedas*.

Therefore those devotees who have obtained Almighty Lord in this life and upon whom the mercy and blessings of Almighty Lord are always there, they are very lucky and they need not perform any *Vrata-Tapa-Japa-Tirth or Daan* in their life. Though such devotees live in this mortal world, yet they enjoy the divine pleasure of the company of the Almighty Lord in *Paramdham*. But for that one needs to have eyes to look around. An owl does not need the sunlight because it is always found sleeping during the daytime. Even the great Kavi Narsinh Mehta has sung: “હેત વિના હુંકરો નો ટેવો જેનું હરખે શુંદેયું ન દિશે રે” While responding to the depth of the knowledge of Uddhavji, Gopis used to tell that, even if a wind would pass through the bones of our burnt bodies, then it would play and emit the sound, “He Krishna, He Krishna” because every iota of our body is saturated with devotion towards Lord Krishna and the word ‘Krishna’ and very flesh and bones of our body have got a new life granted by the Lord Krishna.

“પુલસી સો સબ ભાતી પરમહિત, પૂજય પ્રાન તે ઘારો,
જ સો હોય સેહ રામપદ, યે તો મતો હમારો.”

While summarizing the essence of this human life, the intelligent poet Tulsidasji says that, the Lord is dearer to him even than his life and he has been cherishing ardent faith and devotion towards the Almighty Lord. Similarly, those Paramahamsas, who melted their lives in the worship of the Lord, their life is assessed through Lord Shree Hari. These great saints have performed so ardent devotion and Bhakti of the Almighty Lord Shree Swaminarayan that, they have sung their devotion in thousands of *Padas* and couplets.

SAHJANAND SWAMI GRACED AHMEDABAD

During the times around 1818 A.D. Vitthalrai Babaji was Hakem of Ahmedabad. He was always found surrounded by the persons of false praise. In 1816 A.D. Lord Shree Sahjanand Swami graced Ahmedabad city along with the saints, Parshads and armed Kathi Haribhaktas. Someone misguided Vitthalrai Babaji that, Sahjanand Swami and his saints are not real saints and they may create danger against his rule. Being misguided, Vitthalrai conspired to kill Sahjanand Swami and his saints and devotees; accordingly, he invited Sahjanand Swami to his castle, insisted to take a seat on the high pedestal but Sahjanand Swami refused and stated that, he cannot sit on the seat higher than the seat of a king. While leaving the castle, Sahjanand Swami pressed the seat meant for him with a stick and found that under the seat was a huge bowl of boiled oil; this revealed the conspiracy of the king and he got irritated and ordered Sahjanand Swami to get out of the territory of his kingdom; Sahjanand Swami smiled and asked when he should return back. The angry king replied that, Swami may not return to Ahmedabad until there was his rule.

Thereafter it so happened that the Britishers took disadvantage of a scuffle of Vitthalrai with Gaikwar State of Vadodara and in a very short period the kingdom was

snatched away from Vitthalrai and the British Officer Andrew Dunlop, the Collector of Kheda district took charge of the city of Ahmedabad.

On establishment of the British Company Rule in Ahmedabad city, Sahjanand Swami again graced Ahmedabad and the British Government warmly welcomed him and also granted a huge piece of land for construction of the temple of Sampradaya and registered the said land in the name of Sampradaya. Thereafter as per the directions of Shree Sahjanand Swami, Sadguru Anandanand Swami got constructed a beautiful temple with three domes. And on the pious day of Falgun Sud-3 Samvat 1878, Sunday 28-02-1822, the Lord Shree Swaminarayan installed the idol images of the Lord Shree Narnarayandev in Pathakwadi area in Kalupur of Ahmedabad. This temple enjoys the pride of being the first ever temple of Shree Swaminarayan Sampradaya. The time of the British Rule and the first temple of Shree Swaminarayan temple is almost contemporary and simultaneous and therefore a slogan became popular among the people that *Chandlo* and hat came together. However, later on the hat of the British Raj had to go away and *Chandlo* of Sampradaya remained as a shelter of the thousands of people and devotees of Sampradaya in the country as well as all over the world.

Thaal of Thor to the Lord Shree Narnarayandev

It may be informed with joy and pleasure to the whole Satsang that, since long Seva and Pooja to Thakorji Shree Vitthalnathji of Vaishnav Sampradaya is being performed in our Sampradaya. It was the ardent desire of many devotees that *Thaal of Thor* may be offered to Thakorji. When ardently requested to H.H. Shri Acharya Maharaj in this regard, H.H. Shri Acharya Maharaj has joyously granted permission. So henceforth *Thaal of Thor* would be offered to Thakorji in *Rajbhog*. This *Thaal of Thor* would be booked one day in advance for rendering services of Rs.1500/-.

Shree Hari tied with Love

Any Satsangi would not be unaware about the name of the devotee Parvatbhai of Agatrai. Name of Parvatbhai comes in first row of the devotees of the Sampradaya like the king Janak and Atmanivedi Ambarish. Once Shree Hari graced the village Agatrai of Parvatbhai suddenly and informed him, "We want to get sick whether you say yes or no."

The devotee Parvatbhai bowed down to Shree Hari and requested him not to get sick and to allow them to avail the benefit of rendering services. Accepting the ardent request of the devotee Parvatbhai, Shreeji Maharaj stayed for just two days; but the devotee Parvatbhai observed a kind of mental disturbance in Shree Hari.

From there Maharaj graced the Darbar of Zinabhai of Panchala. Maharaj told him, "We want to get sick." The devotee was shocked to hear this. How can a shady tree think about uprooting itself? But while preparing the bed for Maharaj the devotee Zinabhai thought that *Leela* of Maharaj is unique. Maharaj observed the perturbed face of the devotee; therefore Maharaj did not tell anything, just stayed for a night and went away in the morning. "Really! Death and the guest do not wait for anybody." These words of Maharaj more perturbed the devotee Zinabhai. He thought, "I have never denied anything to Maharaj. Then how can Maharaj prefer to get sick in Panchala?"

From there Maharaj graced the village Piplana and there also expressed his desire of getting sick before the devotees of the village but did not get proper response from any of the devotees of the village. From there, Maharaj graced the house of the devotee Kesarba in the village Varjang Jaliya. There was no limit of the pleasure of the devotees Hirabhai and Kesarbai.

Maharaj told them, "We want to get sick." Innocent Kesarba told, "Maharaj! You may do as per your wish!" Then Maharaj actually got sick in the village Varjang Jaliya. Kesarbai and her husband Hirabhai rendered the services to Maharaj like anything. Maharaj himself took the precautionary measures and started fasting.

When Kesarba asked Maharaj what he

wanted in the meals. Maharaj used to play joke by asking such things which would not be available in the village. When the devotees could not bring the demanded item, Maharaj would tell them why he was being asked to stay when they were not able to offer what was demanded from them.

Once Maharaj demanded hot & fresh *Jalebi* in the midnight. Kesarba woke up Hirabhai; both of them went to Bhayavadar, ordered the sweet to one person, got *Jalebi* prepared, and offered the demanded remuneration to the cook. Both Kesarba and Hirabhai brought the sweet home and offered it in front of Maharaj with utmost devotion!!!

The next day in the morning Maharaj asked the host devotees to bring five pots of water of the river Venu which was flowing near the village Jaliya; Maharaj expressed his desire of taking bath with this water. The water was brought and Maharaj took bath with the water. The sickness of Maharaj evaporated miraculously.

Thereafter the devotee Kesarba offered all types of meals and sweets to Maharaj and Maharaj would accept it joyously. While offering the meals to Maharaj, Kesarba thought if they had a son like this, they would have been able to offer him meals everyday. The omniscient Maharaj smiled at the devotee, stayed at the house of the devotee for 45 days and availed to the devotees the benefit of offering all kinds of meals. In this way **Shree Hari was tied with Love!!!**

Due to some reason, finger of the right leg of the image broke and therefore Shri Nirdoshanand Swami said that there cannot be poojan of this idol image and a new idol image should replace this image and directed to offer the broken idol image in the water of the ocean. But devotees of the temple thought to bury the idol image under the sand of the seashore. While they were carrying the idol image in a bullock cart, one wheel of the cart broke; therefore the devotees made the arrangements for another cart and started carrying the image towards the ocean. On the way the axel of the cart broke. Therefore, the devotees requested the driver of one truck to help them to carry the idol image upto the ocean. They also told him to pay the rent for his vehicle. The driver got ready. But the moment the image was placed in the vehicle, the truck did not start and once started it could not be driven ahead; however, it could run in reverse direction. When the driver checked the engine and all other vital machines of the vehicle, they were found in order and functioning properly. When the truck was again started, it went only in reverse direction. The devotees sitting in side the truck started

talking among themselves. Earlier the wheel of the bullock cart, thereafter the axel of the cart and now the truck; nothing helps us in going ahead. The driver overheard their talk. Immediately he asked the devotees to bring down the idol image as he did not want the idol image to be carried upto the seashore; he neither wanted any rent.

The young devotees and other Haribhaktas thought that, in the morning they would carry the idol image upto seashore and there they would bury the idol image under the sand. So they took the image upto seashore at night and started digging a big deep ditch. But within no time, heavy storm started. The sand and the stones carried by the storm struck on the face of the devotees. All the devotees got frightened and ran away and returned to Hari Mandir in Jiragadh. In one of the devotees, Rokadiya Hanumanji came and asked the devotees in the divine speech to install the same broken idol image in the temple. Listening to the divine speech, the devotees brought the same broken idol image of Rokadiya Hanumanji and Shri Nana Nand Swami performed the invocation of the idol images in the temple..

Thus, there is divine power in the idol image of Rokadiya Hanumanji of Jiragadh. Even today, many people perform some Badha-Aakhdi when they get their desired work done. Every year, H.H. Shri Acharya Maharaj graces Patotsav of Shree Rokadiya Hanumanji of Jiragadh.

How to become Sahjanandi Lion?

Friends! We are Satsangi. We are the devotees of the Lord Shree Swaminarayan and we should be proud of being so. One man of North Gujarat became a Minister in the Government. From the very second day, he stopped visiting the temple. His family was regular in performing Darshan in temple. From the second day, the whole family stopped visiting the temple. When one Sadhu of the temple asked for the reason, the family members replied that now they felt shame to come on scooter being the family members of a minister. They also said that, they would come to the village when the government would allot a car with red light to the Minister.

When family members of a person, who has become a minister, can feel so proud; why can't we cherish such pride when we have attached ourselves with the Almighty Lord Shree Swaminarayan. Why don't feel such a current in ourselves! In Satsang one should not have these Three Attitudes and all the devotees are warned to be alert against these attitudes. These three attitudes are of a Snake, Monkey and a Goat. Our saints give many examples.

Once a snake-charmer was passing by a village, he had three animals. One was snake, another was a monkey and the third one was a goat. During his journey he came across a river. He desired to cross the river carrying all the three animals. So he put the snake in a bamboo basket, placed the monkey upon his shoulder and held the goat under his arm. The snake-charmer knew swimming. But a monkey cannot miss showing his temperament. When it started raining, the monkey took the bamboo basket upon his head; but the snake could not tolerate further heavy rain and it slipped out of the basket into the river. Immediately the monkey jumped into the water to catch the rain. Observing this, the snake-charmer tried to hold the monkey and the goat slipped out of his arm and got drowned

in the river. The snake-charmer wanted to save all the three animals; but he lost all of them. This little story is symbolic- snake, monkey and goat are three human attitudes.

i) The hissing angry attitude of a man is an attitude of a snake.

ii) Instable mental attitude of a man is an attitude of a monkey.

iii) Cowardly attitude of a man is an attitude of a goat.

The hissing attitude of getting angry time and again is not good for a man. Lord Shree Swaminarayan states, "All saints and satsangis are our relatives. All of us have stayed together. And we shall remain united. We cannot be separated even if we wish so. We have always to stay together in this world as well as in *Paramdham* i.e. *Akshardham*. Our saints say that hissing attitude of a snake is pride. Such a temperament is not good for a satsangi. A real satsangi becomes happy when he observes others performing worship and Bhakti of the Lord. Satsangis should be tolerant. If they are reprimanded or rebuked by others, they should think that only near and dear ones do so because they love us. Any layman or any stranger would not do so because he is not concerned with what we do or think. A satsangi, who tolerates the rebukes of the saints, can win his own pride.

The instable attitude of a monkey is another difficulty of a human being. A person went to a Swami and expressed his difficulties. Swami asked him to perform chanting eleven *Mala* of the name of the Almighty Lord. After one week, the man returned to Swami. He complained that there was no improvement in his plight. Swami asked the man to have patience. One can not take the mangoes immediately after sowing the seeds of the mango tree. A person should make efforts, he should pray and he should wait for the right time having patience then only he gets success.

A man was suffering from the stomach-

ache. So he went to the doctor, he took the medicines twice in a day but did not get himself cured. He again went to the doctor and took one injection but in vain. He approached another doctor and took two injections but futile. He went to a person knowing sorcery and asked for the cure of his pain. This is called instable attitude. If this man would have cherished patience and faith in one doctor, he would have got himself cured. So when a person who cherishes faith and patience in the Almighty Lord and the saints, his such instable attitude is removed.

The cowardly attitude of a goat is not good for a devotee. If he has no enthusiasm in his *Bhajan-Bhakti, Katha-Varta* then anyone can drag him to any direction, because his attitude is like a goat. But can anyone dare to direct a lion? Persons who are cowardly by their nature or temperament can be led in any direction but a brave devotee cannot be shaken from his path. A person who worships the Lord Shree Swaminarayan cannot be dragged away and he becomes brave- **A Sahjanandi Lion.**

Friends! Can any person lead his life with only one breathing? One may argue that, without breathing life is not possible. This is true but merely breathing is not life. To lead a life in real sense one also needs trust and confidence. Breathing controls merely our body whereas trust and confidence control the whole life. There was one Ashram in one forest. One Mahatma along with his one hundred disciples was residing in this Ashram. These disciples used to render services and learn Vedas from their Guru. 'Purpose of this Human Life'**

Today people abuse and misuse their life very much. In fact our human birth is very rare because, one gets birth as a human being, after taking birth in eighty four lac births and after suffering the woes of the womb, a soul gets birth of human life. Now the woes of the womb are more woeful than the miseries of *Kumbhi Pak Narka* as described in the scriptures. While in the womb of the mother, a soul has the knowledge and consciousness of hundred lives and prays to the Almighty Lord to grant him freedom from the woes of this womb. But once the soul takes birth in this world, it forgets everything and gets lost in the Maya of this world. Paramatma (the Supreme Soul) gives many opportunities but the human soul does not strive for his own emancipation. Then what is the purpose and meaning of this human life?

In this connection, H.H. Shri Gadiwala states that, just as a painter is found lost in making a beautiful painting. We find that, he is not aware about the day-night or heat and cold of the weather. He remains concentrated in his work and keeps on doing his work. At that time we feel that, what he would do after completing this painting. But on completion of one painting, he takes up another painting and starts the work thereon. It would not do if you do not make your life meaningful because we have obtained this human life very rarely and we do not know whether we would again get this human birth. Perhaps, one may again get human birth but then it is not sure whether he would again get Satsang. This rare company of Satsang is very valuable in our life and it should not be allowed to be wasted. Just as real use of money lies in its proper utilization.

There was a rich person. He was so much rich that, he had golden bricks yet he was very greedy; and he was not managing his money properly. He did not use his money. He would open his treasure in the morning, count them and feel happy but he would not make use of it. His son was very intelligent. He knew that his father was very greedy which is not proper. So he got prepared brazen bricks which looked

exactly like the golden bricks. One day he replaced the golden bricks with the brazen bricks in so smart way that, his father could not know it.

Similarly, a person may perform all the daily rituals of *Pooja-Path, Bhakti* etc. and feels that his work is over. But this is not true, he should understand the importance of this rare human life and should keep on performing *Satsang* and *Bhajan-Bhakti* regularly. A man does not know that, his inner enemies are his anger, pride, greed and excessive affection towards anything. We do not know when any of these inner enemies would raise their heads against us; so we should keep on performing *Satsang* regularly and thereby we would be able to prevent the attach of these enemies. But without *Satsang*, a man cannot know about his place in human life.

Every man feels that, whatever he is doing is just and proper. But it is not so. By performing *Satsang*, a man confesses his weaknesses and thereby gets an opportunity to improve them. By remaining in *Satsang*, he gets the ability to identify thousands of his inner enemies; he also gets the understanding that, he has come in *Satsang* to get rid of all these weaknesses. Therefore, while performing *Satsang*, a person has to find out his condition at the time just before he entered into *Satsang* and his present condition. Umpoint number of infirmities of thousands of previous lives are lying hidden in all of us. We need to identify them and it is essential to get rid of them. Therefore it is essential to perform *Satsang* because it is through *Satsang* that we get the abilities to identify our inner infirmities and weaknesses and we also get the ways and means to get rid of them. Even Shreeji Maharaj has stated in *Vachanamrit*, "Obtaining Moksha (emancipation) is the ultimate goal and purpose of human life."

A Lemon Tree in Darbargadh


